A typical day's cleaning schedule

Arrive at office	7:30 AM
Load Willow Maid Car and start traveling to your first customer	
Customer #1 starts	8:00 AM
Customer #1 ends	10:30 AM
30 minute drive time to next customer	
30 minute morning break / early lunch	
Customer #2 starts	11:30 AM
Customer #2 ends	2:00 PM
30 minute drive to next customer	
Customer #3 starts	2:30 PM
Customer #3 ends	4:30 PM
Report back to the office	
Arrive at office	5:00 PM
<u>Unload the car and prepare for the next day's customers</u>	
Leave the office to go home	5:15 PM

In the above example, you get paid for 7 hours. Since each job can end 15 minutes early, Teams are often back to the office 45 minutes early and on their way home by 4:30 PM.

Part Time Employees

Part time employees still work a full day as outlined in the above time chart. We do not offer partial work days.

Tell us what days you can work a full day and we will work around your schedule.

COMPENSATION – HOW YOU GET PAID

Your pay is based on an hourly rate for the time allocation **expected** to complete the job. You are paid for each job you work. This is similar to compensation plans for mechanics.

If you complete the job early then, you still get paid the full amount based on the time allocation. If you go over time, you only get paid the allocation of time. Our time and pricing tool is very accurate in predicting allocated time requirements. 95% of the time you will finish before the time allocation expires (15 minutes early on average). Typically, less than 5% of jobs go over the allocation of time. And if they do, it's not much. If you are a veteran cleaner, you can appreciate how important this is. We take care of our employees by providing jobs based on realistic timetables that allow some breathing room. Our company is built around you, so you will love working here.

Because you can finish a job early and still get paid the full amount, this is technically a commission paid job.



We do NOT pay for drive time

The average drive time between jobs is less than 30 minutes. If the average drive time happens to go over 30 minutes, we will pay you for the excess drive time. It doesn't happen very often, but if it does happen, we take care of our employees and pay them for the excess time. Drive time pay is paid at \$10 an hour for Team Leader and \$9 an hour for Cleaning Partner.

Guarantee Pay for New Certifed Cleaners on New Teams

Customers reschedule or skip service from time to time. This results in your pay ranging from week to week. You will typically work between 25 - 35 hours a week cleaning homes. Occasionally you may have a week where there are lots of reschedules or cancellations. When that occurs we still guarantee new certified employees that are placed on a new team gross pay of \$300 a week for Cleaning Partner and \$400 a week for Team Leader.

Our second biggest expense is advertising for new customers. We know how important it is to keep our employees busy. Guarantee Pay is rarely offered in any industry, and we know it. We are happy to provide guarantee pay because it doesn't occur very often and because we keep our employees busy.

Willow Maids will sponsor and pay for your on-line training classes through *Maid Training Academy* to earn your Professional Cleaner certification. *Team Leader* certification classes are also available for those who want to advance their career. **Our goal is your success.**



Job Requirements – All Cleaners

- Pass a criminal background check.
- Pass a drug test We are a drug-free workplace.
- Have the physical strength to work a full day on your feet.
- Bend to dust/clean items from top to bottom. This job requires a lot of bending.
- Be able to work on hands and knees in certain areas including reaching under furniture.
- Work well with others and have a good attitude. Be professional at all times.
- Load and unload vehicle with equipment used to clean lift 25-pound vacuum and caddy.
- Move rugs and other items under 25 pounds to get to all floors.
- Prepare cleaning products for the next day and process your dirty cloths through the laundry.
- Have good hands. Handle dusting tasks without dropping or breaking items cleaned/dusted.
- Have good balance and not prone to tripping or slipping
- Cannot exceed time off policy And cannot be tardy to work.
- Provide high-quality cleaning every time you clean a home.
- Maintain a professional appearance at all times.

If you are already certified, great. Simply provide a copy of your certificate. If you are not, no problem. If we like you, we will pay for your certification classes.

We work with *Maid Training Academy*. They provide on-line training courses for Residential Maids. If you are selected, we will purchase your training material and testing, but we do not pay for your time to take the class. It's a scholarship to learn how professional maids clean homes. The class cost \$200, and we pay for the class.

There are two classes. Level-1 takes approximately 4 hours including reading a 67-page book and taking the on-line Practice Test, a few times. Level-2 is a 79 page manual and takes about 5 hours to complete the course.
